

Dear Friends of the St. Francis Cathedral School Community,

It has been six years since I was named the chairperson of the Msgr. Richard A. Behl Endowment Fund. Msgr. Behl was the rector here at the Cathedral when my girls attended SFCS. He was the inspiration for my involvement in the foundation and has been my guiding light. He was truly a remarkable man.

I have seen this fund grow substantially over this time, resulting from the ever-increasing contributions from our family of donors. As a direct result, I am proud to report that this past year, the foundation was able to contribute \$38,000 to the Cathedral school for purchases of technology upgrades, from interest earned on our investments! We have since received 100 new devices, as we near the end of phase 1 of our technology upgrade initiative. Twenty-five new teacher devices have been set up and are replacing 10-year-old laptops that were currently in use. The remaining 75 devices will be for our kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade classrooms. Phase 2 of the initiative will be upgrading our ten-year-old classroom Smart Boards which will begin with the purchase of one for the computer lab.

It is with a heavy heart that I report I will be stepping down as chairperson of the foundation. We all have crosses to bear, and I have been dealing with some health issues for the past few years. Therefore, in the best interest of the foundation, I am pleased to announce that committee member, Ms. Patricia Bixel has been named the next committee chairperson. Pat was the head of the guidance department for many years at Mount Saint Mary Academy and volunteers in several capacities here at the Cathedral. Pat will also be our first female committee chairperson!

I am grateful to all the committee members, particularly Elaine Scull, Foundation Administrator, who has been not only my right hand, but at times my left hand as well. I am truly blessed to have worked with such fine dedicated professionals. God willing, I will remain on board as a committee member. Thank you, St. Francis Cathedral School supporters and benefactors! Without your generosity, our work here at SFCS could not be accomplished. Please continue to support our Blue Ribbon School's high level of excellence for future generations of students.


