Gospel: John 10:11-18

The fourth Sunday of Easter is also called Good Shepherd Sunday Gospel. Jesus makes a radical statement when he declares himself to be the Good Shepherd.

Jesus describes his relationship with his followers as similar to the relationship between a good shepherd and his sheep. As a good shepherd will risk and lay down his life in order to protect his sheep, Jesus willingly sacrifices himself for the sake of his sheep.

Jesus says that the actions of the good shepherd are based upon the relationship that develops between the shepherd and the sheep. The good shepherd knows the sheep and therefore acts out of love. For the Good Shepherd, this is never simply part of a job; this love-in-action is integral to his identity.

This week, let us dwell on the Lord's loving relationship with us, as he guides us and shepherd us away from harm.


