## SAINT GABRIEL FOOD CUPBOARD

Our parish provides food assistance to help our neighbors. It operates out of the lower level of the school hall on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings from 9:00 - 10:30 am. During the summer it is open on Tuesdays & Fridays. Our parishioners are asked to bring non-perishable food items with them to Mass on the first Sunday of the month.

## SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:** All couples who plan to have their baby baptized at St. Gabriel should notify the rectory for appropriate preparation. Sponsors must be Confirmed and at least 16 years of age. They are required to bring a letter from their parish stating that they are practicing Catholics. Baptisms are usually held the fourth Sunday of the month at the 10:00 am Mass.

**SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confession):** Saturdays from 3:00 to 4:00 pm or anytime by appointment.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY:** The Archdiocese requires that couples planning to marry must contact the parish at least six months before the intended date. All couples are required to attend pre-marital instructions in preparation for marriage.

**ANointing OF THE SICK:** In case of serious illness or advanced age, please call the rectory. Priests and Eucharistic ministers distribute communion to those who are sick and elderly, as well as to those unable to attend Mass. Sick calls should not be deferred until the person is unconscious or in imminent danger of death.

**PARISH REGISTRATION:** New parishioners are most welcome. Please call the rectory to make an appointment with the pastor. Please notify the rectory if you move. If you never receive a mailing from the parish you are not in our registry; contact us to give us your current information.

**BECOMING CATHOLIC:** We would be most happy to assist those interested in becoming Catholic. Please contact the pastor for information.

**August 29nd, The 22nd Sunday in  
Ordinary Time  
"A Word from the Pastor"**

**"Thy will be done!"** The familiar line from the ***Our Father*** is repeated many times throughout the Bible, in both Old and New Testaments. The wording varies, but the message is the same: *Obedying God is an act of faith and love; it is essential to our Christian Faith!* Today there is a spontaneous rebellion, even rejection, to *"being told"* what to do by anyone, any thing, or any institution, even by God and His Church. Obedience is viewed as a loss or deprivation of freedom. *Freedom* is viewed as having the right to do anything I want to do. But that is *mistaking Freedom for License!* *Freedom can NEVER be separated from responsibility!* For example, I am not free to ignore the rules of traffic and driving, because to do so puts other people in danger, and *I Am Responsible* for the safety of other people when I drive. Another example, I am NOT free to ignore or violate my vows as a priest, because *I Am Responsible* for witnessing to the Gospel and teaching by example, and if I scandalize people by my behavior, then I hurt and damage the Church and the faith of God's people.

Moses declares to the people, *"Now, Israel, hear the statutes and decrees which I am teaching you to observe... Observe them carefully, for thus will you give evidence of your wisdom and intelligence to the nations..."* (Deut. 4: 1 & 6) God's commandments do not take away our freedom, rather they *Protect us* from being hurt or hurting others, and they *teach us the True Value* of the people and things being protected. *We keep God's commandments because it is the smart thing to do. When we obey, we are truly free to grow and prosper in a world where all are treated with dignity and respect!*

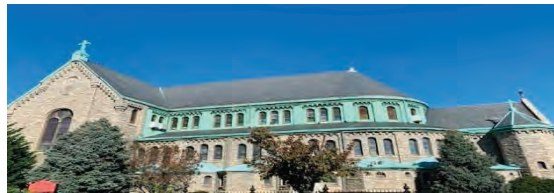
