SAINT GABRIEL FOOD CUPBOARD

During the summer it is open on Tuesdays & Fridays. Our parishioners are asked to bring non-perishable food items with them to Mass on the first Sunday of the month.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: All couples who plan to have their baby baptized at St. Gabriel should notify the rectory for appropriate preparation. Sponsors must be Confirmed and at least 16 years of age. They are required to bring a letter from their parish stating that they are practicing Catholics. Baptisms are usually held the fourth Sunday of the month at the 10:00 am Mass.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confession): Saturdays from 3:00 to 4:00 pm or anytime by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY: The Archdiocese requires that couples planning to marry must contact the parish at least six months before the intended date. All couples are required to attend premarital instructions in preparation for marriage.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: In case of serious illness or advanced age, please call the rectory. Priests and Eucharistic ministers distribute communion to those who are sick and elderly, as well as to those unable to attend Mass. Sick calls should not be deferred until the person is unconscious or in imminent danger of death.

PARISH REGISTRATION: New parishioners are most welcome. Please call the rectory to make an appointment with the pastor. Please notify the rectory if you move. If you never receive a mailing from the parish you are not in our registry; contact us to give us your current information.

BECOMING CATHOLIC: We would be most happy to assist those interested in becoming Catholic. Please contact the pastor for information.

THE OPENING OF THE EUCHARISTIC RENEWAL IN THE ARCHDIOCESE AND AT ST. GABRIEL PARISH

The Bishops of the United States have initiated a three-year Eucharistic Revival, "to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord, Jesus Christ, in the Holy Eucharist." The Eucharistic Revival has a three-fold approach:

- (1.) First, foster excellence, dignity, and devotion in the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass;
- (2.) Second, teach of the faithful (intentional catechesis) on the reality of Christ ever present in the Holy Eucharist; and
- (3.) Third, cultivate a deeper devotion to and love of the Lord in the Holy Eucharist, through Holy Hours, Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament, and a renewal of the 40 Hours Devotion.

At St. Gabriel Parish we are focused on offering Mass in a spirit of reverence and devotion, treating the Liturgy with the dignity it deserves, and doing all we can to enhance the beauty and spiritually enriching experience for all who join us at Mass. In sermons and on social media, we intentionally do all we can, to develop the faith of all our people. Finally, we are re-introducing the 40 Hours Devotion, beginning on St. Gabriel Sunday, October 2nd, and concluding with Vespers, on Tuesday, October 4th.

The Holy Eucharist and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass are the *"source and summit"* of our worship, faith, and relationship with Almighty God. Over the next three years the Church is committed to rediscovering the treasures of God's grace and life in the Holy Eucharist. I invite you to accompany us on this journey of faith at St. Gabriel Parish!
