With this in mind, St. Philip Neri School has updated its COVID protocols, with new protocols becoming effective on November 4, 2024.

Prevention – Ways to avoid illness

- Stay up to date with vaccinations.
- Practice good hygiene.
- Practice respiratory etiquette.
- SPN is cleaned throughout the school day and every night, encourages hand washing, and provides hand sanitizer.

Exposure

• Take a COVID test as soon as possible if you believe you have bene exposed.

Infection – If your child tests positive for COVID:

- If your child is experiencing respiratory virus symptoms, keep your child home.
- If your child tests positive for COVID, email the Principal ASAP at RHILL@STPHILIPNERI.ORG.
- Your child may return to school when:
 - ➤ Symptoms are improving.
 - ➤ No fever for 24 hours without the use of medication.
 - ➤ The student will be required to wear a mask to school, while indoors, for 5 days upon return.
