A Note about COVID Cases

I've received a few questions about COVID cases at Lumen Christi and how they're communicated. In our COVID plan, we committed to informing the community when a student or staff member has tested positive on a PCR test, even though the regulations require only that we inform "close contacts" who need to quarantine. We informed parents of two separate cases of COVID among students and staff in early September and have had no further cases so far since then.

We communicate only about cases among the students or staff – in other words, individuals who are in the school. We do not communicate about cases among family members or situations where a student or staff member must quarantine because of close contact with someone outside the school.
