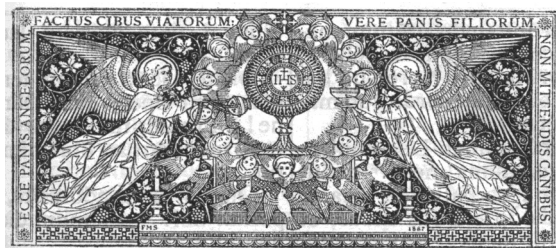

## *Pastor Father Bill's Weekly Column*

Dear Parish Family,

It goes without saying that over recent decades membership and participation in the life of the Church has declined precipitously, particularly over the past couple of years due in part to the coronavirus pandemic. The Church is no longer a major driving force of culture and life in the modern world. Attendance at Mass, participation in the sacraments, and ordinary devotional practice are no longer a significant part in the lives of a vast number of people. While this situation can at times seem bleak, we must never despair — Jesus Christ is risen from the dead, therefore we always have firm hope.

To meet the challenges the present situation provides, we who believe and practice our faith must do so with renewed vigor and zeal. Recall that the Apostles were only twelve, one of whom betrayed the Lord. But empowered by the Holy Spirit and emboldened by faith in the Risen Lord, those twelve set out with missionary fervor, preaching the Gospel and multiplying the number of the faithful, such that believe in Jesus Christ is present in every time and place in human history since. The Church of the year 2021 needs the same missionary spirit of the Apostles in the year 33.

In order to facilitate renewal in the Church of the Diocese of Madison, Bishop Hying has asked all parishes to conduct a survey. This survey is open to all, whether you attend Mass daily or only a few times per year. The intention of this survey is to gauge the faith and needs of the people of this parish, and determine how our parish can better aid the faithful on the path of holiness.

I am asking all of you to take 15 minutes or so to fill out this survey. As I have only been your pastor for a few months, it will be particularly helpful to me in gauging the pastoral needs of our parish.

We must remember that the whole goal and purpose of life is to know Jesus Christ, be saved by his love, and help others to do the same. With hope in the power of the risen Christ, I firmly believe the God can bring renewal to his Church and renewal to our parish.
