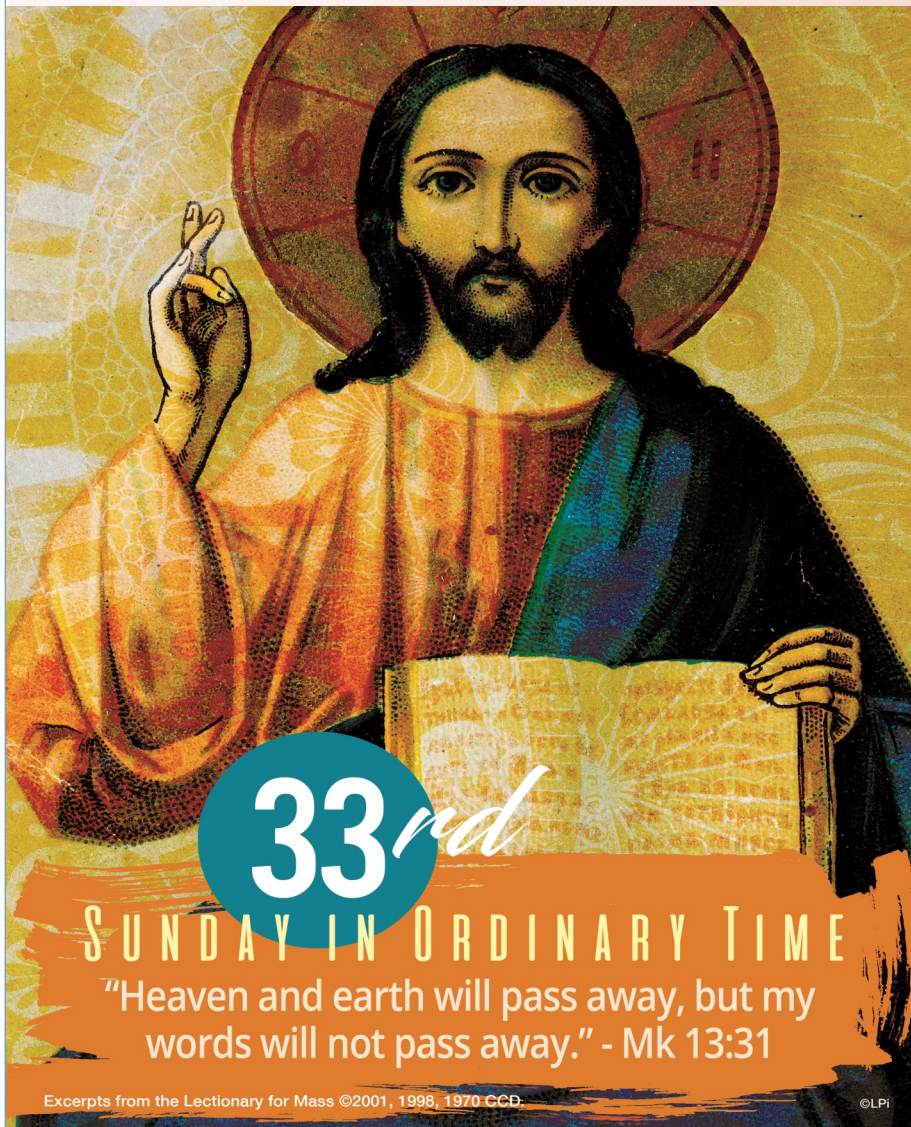

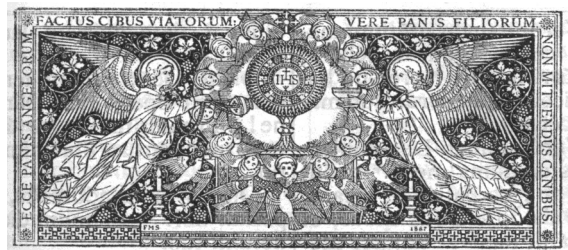

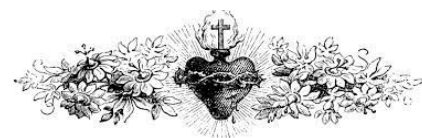
We need to keep striving for holiness and saintliness! We shouldn't give up our dream of reaching the Heavens!

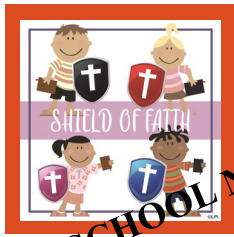
Nothing Compares to Such a Reward!

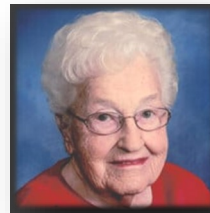
