

MESSAGE FROM FR. JACK GRAHAM, PASTOR

In 1979 Mother Teresa of Calcutta, now Saint Teresa, was the unexpected winner of the Nobel Peace prize. There was something that Mother did that shocked the world. As she stood on the stage in Stockholm to receive her award, Mother Theresa said this: "The single greatest threat to world peace today is abortion". To say that the room fell into a stunned silence is an understatement.

There has been no greater defender of human dignity and the right to life than Mother Teresa. While her words were strong, her actions were gentle and compassionate. Mother never railed against those who had abortions. She understood that so many of those who had abortions were also victims. She knew that so many of those young women had found themselves in difficult situations and often acted out of fear and ignorance. If a woman who had had an abortion and asked for her help, that woman was met with love, compassion, and tenderness.

One of my favorite pictures is one showing Mother Teresa, on a visit to New York, meeting with Dorothy Day. Dorothy Day, like Mother Teresa, had a great love for those in need. Her Catholic Worker movement established Houses of Hospitality to help meet the needs of those struggling to survive in early $20^{\rm th}$ century America. Dorothy Day's cause for Sainthood is now being promoted and considered. Day believed that every person was the image of God and should be treated with respect and dignity. In 1974 she signed a

petition against legalized abortion.

In her Autobiography, Dorothy Day writes of her own experience with abortion. In 1919, this great woman, who I believe to be a Saint, had an abortion. She writes about her fear, fear of losing a man she thought she loved and fear of what others would say leading her to make the decision to end her pregnancy. Day writes of the years of depression, guilt, and shame that followed. At one point she even tried to end her own life. Dorothy Day had great empathy, compassion, and love for women who shared her own experience.

I speak a great deal about Abortion; I believe it to be a great evil in today's world. I apologize if my words have hurt or if they have been misunderstood because of my inability to speak clearly. Mother Teresa tells us that we are called to love all those who come are way. We should always welcome those who hurt and help, not chastise them. Dorothy Day is a reminder to all of us that God works through each one of us, often most powerfully, not in spite of our weaknesses but through them. I ask all of us to be mindful of those in our midst who are afraid, confused, and alone. Let us try to help and not vilify. I ask Dorothy Day to pray for me that I be a more compassionate, welcoming person. God Bless,

The word "Alleluia" is a term of great joy meaning "Praise Yahweh" in Hebrew. It is a reminder that the Kingdom of Heaven is already established on earth, in the form of the Church, and that our participation in Mass is a participation in Heaven.

During Lent our focus is on the Kingdom of Heaven coming, not on it already being here. So to emphasize our journey toward the Kingdom of Heaven and remind us to acknowledge our sins and practice repentance so that one day we may have the privilege of entering the Kingdom of Heaven, we remove the use of "Alleluia" from the Mass.
