A message from Father Cyrain....

To follow a fad or fashion or a celebrity is the obsession of so many people which give them a certain "high" and a boost of image. To follow Jesus entails sacrifice and giving up which sometimes goes unrewarded in this lifetime.

There comes a time in the life of every child of God when God invites us to follow him more closely and participate in his mission. This might require a career change and transformation to a means of service; from being self-centered to being God-centered, from entitlement to giving out and seeking God's greater glory for the benefit of mankind, from simple fishermen to fisher of souls.

The peremptory response of the Big Four (Simon, Andrew, James, and John) in leaving their nets and family, points not only to the magnetic and authoritative figure of Jesus but to their complete trust and total surrender.

The call to follow Jesus is still going on and he depends on us for continuing the mission of the first disciples. Shall we courageously set out to make him known or shall we allow our nets to entangle us, still?

Eucharistic Revival:

Nourishing ourselves of the Eucharistic Jesus also means abandoning ourselves trustingly to him and allowing ourselves to be guided by him. It means welcoming Jesus in place of one's own "me." In this way the love freely received from Jesus in the Eucharistic Communion, by the work of the Holy Spirit, nourishes our love for God and for the brothers and sisters we meet along the daily journey. Nourished by the Body of Christ, we become ever more concretely the mystical Body of Christ. (Pope Francis Angelus – June 18, 2017)
