Dear Parishioners,

Friday, June 16th is the Universal Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and coincidentally falls right before the weekend that we celebrate in the secular world, “father’s day.” What do these two themes have in common? Everything!

Jesus is the divine love of God in human form, which means that everything that God the Father desired to reveal about Himself to us, to the human race, He revealed through His son, Jesus; “Philip, don’t you realize...whoever has seen me has seen the Father” (John 14:9). Jesus makes visible to us the invisible love of the Father; He shows us what it looks like by how He loves. The divine, perfect love of God is made visible through the human heart of Jesus – the Sacred Heart. This is why the Church encourages such devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and why there is a renewed movement in the Church to enthrone the Sacred Heart in every home (go to this website for more info: <https://welcomehisheart.com/>).

To St. Margaret Mary Alcoque, a mystic who lived in the 1600s, Jesus gave this mission to spread devotion to his Sacred Heart, to which he attached these 12 promises:

(1) I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life. (2) I will establish peace in their homes. (3) I will comfort them in all their afflictions. (4) I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death. (5) I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings. (6) Sinners will find in My Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy. (7) Lukewarm souls shall become fervent. (8) Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection. (9) I will bless every place in which an image of My Heart is exposed and honored. (10) I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts. (11) Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart. (12) I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in My disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

As we remember our earthly father’s this weekend, let us remember the great love that our Heavenly Father has revealed to us through the Sacred Heart of Jesus, His Son. Have a blessed week.

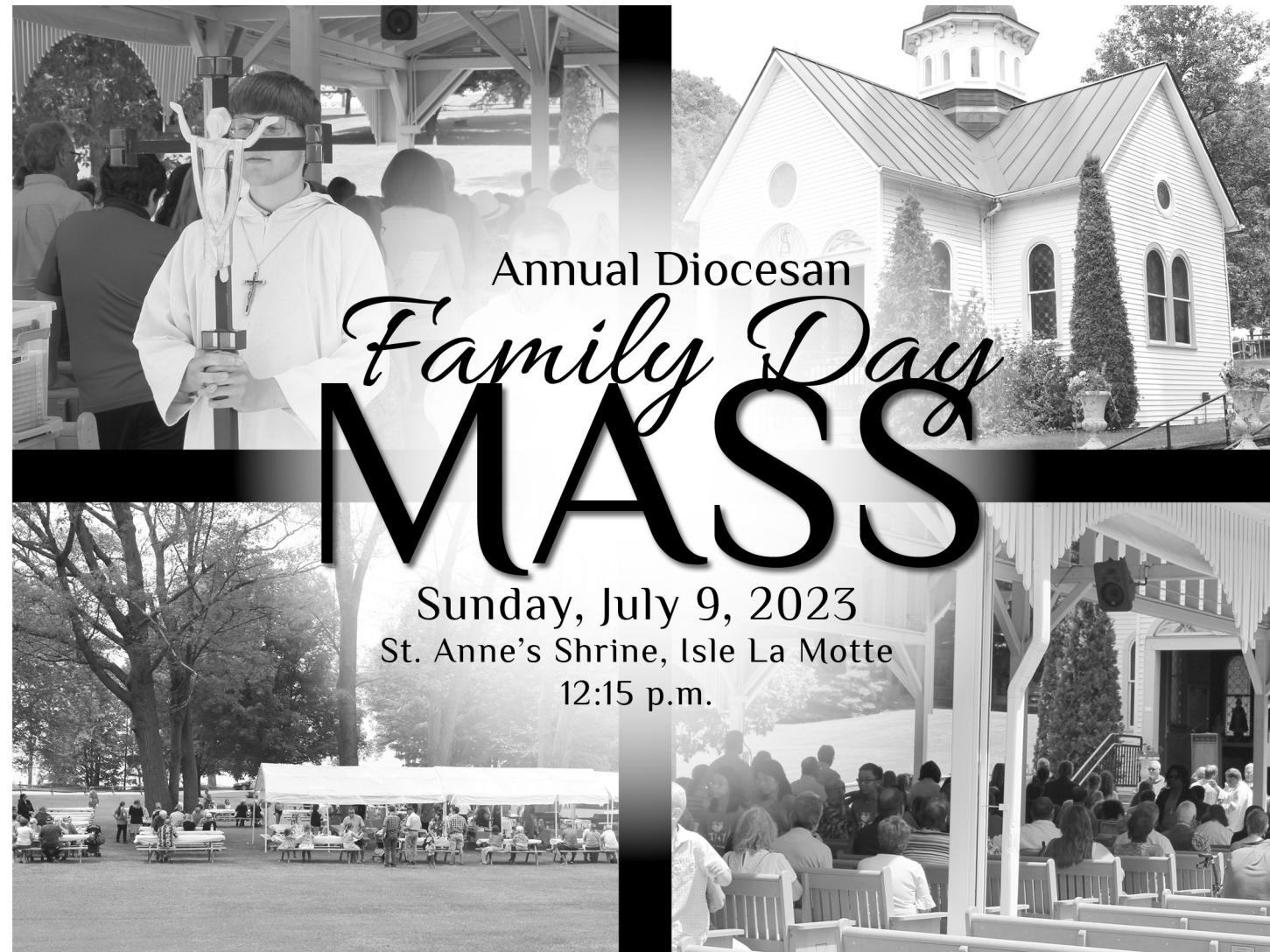

Annual Diocesan Family Day planned at St. Anne's Shrine

The annual Diocesan Family Day Mass will be celebrated July 9 at 12:15 p.m. at St. Anne's Shrine in Isle LaMotte with Burlington Vicar General Monsignor John McDermott as celebrant.

A barbecue will follow.

St. Anne's Shrine is a peaceful, spiritual, and historic site that has been developed and maintained for the past 100 years by the Society of St. Edmund in the Champlain Islands. Each season, thousands of religious pilgrims, vacationers and tourists visit the popular waterfront site in Isle La Motte for devotion and recreation.

The mission of the shrine is to serve as a welcoming place of peace and hope ministering to all God's people through prayer, devotion, hospitality, and spiritual renewal.

Situated on 32 acres, the shrine offers an open-air chapel, rustic grottos, a café, a gift shop, an all-purpose facility and picnic areas.

The shrine will be providing a free-will-donation barbecue after the Family Day Mass as in the past.

Visitors are welcome to bring their own picnic as well as lawn chairs and lawn games.
