Dear Parishioners,

I am deeply grateful for your generous support of my journey home to visit my family in India. Your kindness has touched my heart profoundly. It has been 3 years and 10 months since I visited my family. I'm grateful for all your prayers, especially those for the speedy process of my travel document. It happened also by the intercession of St Padre Pio as I received the document two days before his feast.

I initially planned to go to India in January 2024 for the celebrations of St Paul's Feast, Thanksgiving Day and my niece's baptism (for which she is waiting for 2 years). But Fr Jon was very kind and said, "you have waited enough. It is time to visit your family." Though hesitant at first, I felt excited to go and see my entire family. I'm very grateful to Fr Jon.

I will be leaving for three weeks on 10/15. It is a surprise visit and my family will be shocked to see my gray hair. It will shock my mom very much who dyes her hair. The new house (400 sq ft) which I built for my parents, will be blessed on October 22<sup>nd</sup>. I will be working on a big project to start the Alumni association for St Paul's Higher Secondary School where I had studied. After 5 years on October 24th, I will be celebrating a Holy Mass on my brother's anniversary of death in my home parish. I will take my nieces and nephew on a trip to a waterpark, beach, Shrines, and shopping. In January, I will be able to meet my younger brother who lives in Malta, Europe, so I can baptized his daughter who has been waiting for two years!

As I prepare to embark on this family visit, please know your love and support mean the world to me. A number of parishioners from both parishes donated to cover the entire expenses of my trip home, which is remarkably awesome. I feel so loved. From the financial help I have received, I will donate a day's food to the deaf and the blind students at St Louis Institute, Adyar, Chennai in your name. I'm shopping for gifts and chocolates for my family and neighbors because in my village, the neighbors and friends will expect chocolates from everyone who returns from abroad.

I carry your love with me on this journey, and I will keep all of you in my prayers. May the Lord continue to bless our families abundantly, and may we grow even stronger in our faith and love for one another.






