Guidelines for Receiving Holy Communion

For Catholics to receive Holy Communion, the Church reminds us:

- *a person must not be conscious of unconfessed grave sin.
- *Should have fasted for at least one hour.
- *a person conscious of unconfessed grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior sacramental confession.
- *The Catechism also reminds us that those who deliberately miss Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation commit grave sin.

Confessions are available on Saturday afternoons from 2:45 – 3:30PM or by appointment with Father Furman at 257-5101.

Jubilee Pilgrimage Passport

Want to take a pilgrimage to observe the Jubilee Year of Hope, but Rome isn't an option? Try the Vermont Jubilee pilgrimage route. The Diocese of Burlington has created a simple "passport" that is now available to any parishioner wishing to keep track of their pilgrimage to the Jubilee churches in our diocese. Each of the four churches has been provided with a rubber stamp specifically for these passports. Those who visit a Jubilee Church throughout the year can bring their passport and have it stamped with the name and place of the Jubilee Church. **Passports are available at the entrance.**

The passport has space to record six visits. Two weeks can be a visit to any parish or even special time spent in prayer here in our own parish while the remaining four weeks can be visits to other Jubilee Churches. The Jubilee Year concludes January 6th, 2026.






