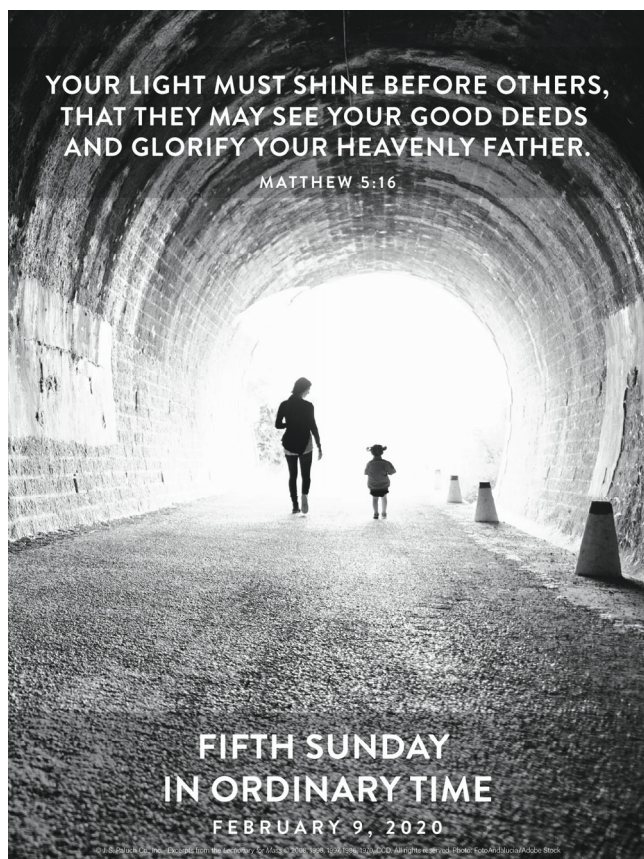

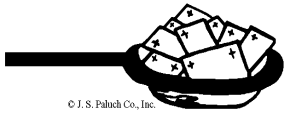

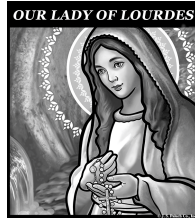

Sidewalks around Holy Rosary have been
affected by frost. Please be cautious as you
enter and leave the church and parish hall.

My name is Mo Humphrey and I'm doing research for the
Richmond Historical Society. Right now I'm working on
Harriet Rigg's collection of historical postcards, digitizing
them and sorting through them. According to Harriet's
notes, the first building was built in 1858 and demolished
after the new brick church was completed in 1955. From
the old images the rectory was built in 1860 and demolished
when the Freeman property was purchased in 1924. I'm not
sure why a property on the south side of the main street
would be the cause though. There is also an old picture of
St. Mary's Hall which sat on the east side of the church and
just behind where the Maple Inn used to be.

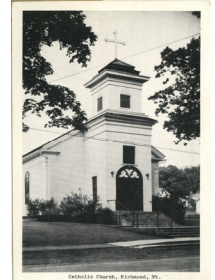
I have attached two images, PR-PC-HR-173 and 174, before
