





The Diocese of Burlington seeks to continue inspiring and equipping lay men and women for leadership roles in their parishes. Two informational webinars regarding upcoming opportunities have been scheduled - see links at the bottom. Also feel free to reach out directly to Dcn. Phil Lawson

Diocesan Lay Formation Leadership Program: This 2-year program that meets one Saturday a month in person with additional formation taking place via online courses, seeks to form laity to assist in leadership roles in their parishes.

Deacon Formation Program: Following formation, deacons are ordained to be permanent ministers in the Church, serving through word, sacrament, and charity. Their total time in formation is five years, two of which are in the Lay Formation Leadership Program, followed by three years of Diaconate Formation. Pastoral Associate for Parish Life: This 1-year formation program is designed to prepare individuals with the knowledge and skills needed to serve a parish in many of its administrative and pastoral tasks, when it is not possible for the Bishop to appoint a full-time parish priest.
