### # From the Pastor's Desk #

Thank you to all who have supported the Annual Bishop's Appeal. The diocese recently sent out a report announcing that as a diocese we have reached 64% of its goal. The report also broke down each parish and I am happy to announce that both of our parishes are doing well: Saint John the Baptist has raised \$15,000 of its \$29,000 goal; Sacred Heart Saint Francis de Sales has raised \$32,000 of its \$56,000 goal. Thank you for your generosity!

A bishop's appeal is a reminder that we are part of a larger church. Not only do we have the needs of our local community to keep in mind we also have the needs of our local church (diocese of Burlington), the universal church (Rome), and churches and charities that have particular and timely needs such as disaster relief. In the Acts of the Apostles, we have an example of how Christians might ideally live: "There was no needy person among them, for those who owned property or houses would sell them, bring the proceeds of the sale, and put them at the feet of the apostles, and they were distributed to each according to need" (Acts 4:34-35).

With our diocese in a transition of leadership, we have another reminder that this appeal is larger than our own bishop. The successor of Archbishop Coyne will inherit the success or lack thereof of this particular appeal. As our diocese continues to celebrate 170 years of ministry in Vermont, I encourage everyone to give as they are able. Our needs are great and with God, all things are possible!
