
First Saturday of the month from 9:30 - 10:30 am and by appointment.

From the Pastor's Desk

January is a special month for the Congregation of Holy Cross. We celebrate Saint Andre Bessette, C.S.C. and Blessed Basil Moreau, C.S.C.. Brother Andre entered eternal life on January 6th, 1937 at the age of 91. Saint Andre is known as the "Miracle Man of Montreal." He is known for his deep devotion to Saint Joseph as he founded the beautiful Oratory of Saint Joseph. Among the thousands of miracles attributed to his intercession, I would like to share a personal story about the graces that I received at the Oratory.

Between high school and college, my pastor took a seminarian and two of us discerning a priestly vocation to the Oratory on a pilgrimage. My prayer on this pilgrimage was clarity on where I should attend seminary: should I study for the Archdiocese of Detroit or the Congregation of Holy Cross? I felt God calling me to parish life, specifically parish life with a school, which seemed to direct me to the archdiocese. I also did not want to move far away from home. Yet something was stirring in my heart ever since I visited the Congregation of Holy Cross in Indiana. Accepted to both programs and deeply conflicted, I found peace in my discernment while praying in the chapel where Brother Andre's heart is located. Only several years later did I discover that Brother Andre belonged to the same community that I joined in Indiana. Grateful for my vocation, I pray "Thank you, Brother Andre!"

I will write about Blessed Basil Moreau next week.


Souper Bowl of Caring on Super Bowl Weekend February 10 - 11
