


Sacrament of Marriage (Weddings)


God our Father, you will all men and women to be saved and come to the knowledge of your Truth,

BIBLE STUDY: THE BIBLE AND SACRAMENTS

WEDNESDAYS - JUNE 6 THROUGH JULY 19, 2023

"The Bible and the Sacraments: Journey through Scripture" will be led by Deacon Dennis Moore beginning on Wednesday, June 7 from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM in the Parish Hall. This series is published by the St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology in Steubenville, Ohio and is a 6-week video and discussion series. The series will continue on Wednesdays through July 19th.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes the sacraments as "the masterworks of God in the new and everlasting covenant." More than mere earthly rituals, they have the power to prepare us for eternal life.

The Bible and the Sacraments is a dynamic video Bible study that explores the deeply scriptural roots of the sacraments. By illuminating the relationship between the Old and New Testaments and their connection to the rites of the Catholic Church, The Bible and the Sacraments reveals the sacramental nature of "God's saving plan for humanity.


