- •Feast Day: July 6
- •Maria Goretti lived in poverty with her family in Italy. When she was 12, she was stabbed 14 times by an 19-year old neighbor, Alessandro Serenelli, because she resisted his advances.
- •As she lay dying in the hospital, Maria forgave her killer and prayed that he would repent and turn to God.
- •After serving six years of a thirty year sentence, Alessandro began having dreams in which Maria appeared to him. He began to repent for his sins.
- •When he was released from prison, he entered a monastery to continue his penance. He and Maria's mother and siblings were together at her canonization in 1950.
