JOIN OUR MUSIC MINISTRY!

Have you considered using your love of music in service at Mass? There are many opportunities for you to use your gifts here at Sacred Heart:

- All children of the Parish – grades 4 through 8 – are invited to join us for our Children’s Choir practices on Wednesdays beginning August 28th! There will be two practice times to accommodate school schedules: 3:00-4:00 p.m. and 4:30-5:15 p.m. (singers choose one to attend). The choir generally sings at the 9:30am Mass on the 4th Sunday of the month, as well as special Masses such as Christmas Eve, Easter Sunday, and First Communion.
- Our Parish Choir is a traditional 4-part choir, for singer’s high school age through adults, which sings music of all styles. The choir leads music at 9:30am Mass on the 2nd and 3rd Sundays and 11:30am Mass on the 4th Sunday, as well as other parish celebration such as Christmas, Confirmation, and Triduum. Practices are on Thursdays from 7:00-8:30 p.m.
- The Contemporary Group is an ensemble of singers and instrumentalists who lead contemporary music worship at the 9:30 a.m. Mass on the 1st Sunday of the month and the 11:30 a.m. Mass on the 3rd Sunday. Adult singers, guitarists, and other instrumentalists are invited to join. Practices vary, but usually alternate Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings.
- Instrumentalists are needed on an occasional basis to accompany our other groups and choirs. Trumpeters, violinists, flutists, etc are encouraged to contact the music director who schedules based on need.
- Have you been thinking of joining our music ministry but weekly choir rehearsals don't fit into your schedule? Consider helping lead our parish in song by becoming a cantor! Cantors are scheduled about once every 4-5 weeks when there is not a choir at Mass. Cantoring is an important way that you can serve our parish and make a great impact on our worship every week. Teens and adults who are a bit more experienced singing alone are encouraged to inquire about this special ministry.

Our music ministry is such a vital ministry here at Sacred Heart and we’d love to have more parishioners involved. We are always willing to train! Please contact music director Nate Jackson if you’d like to volunteer or for more information.

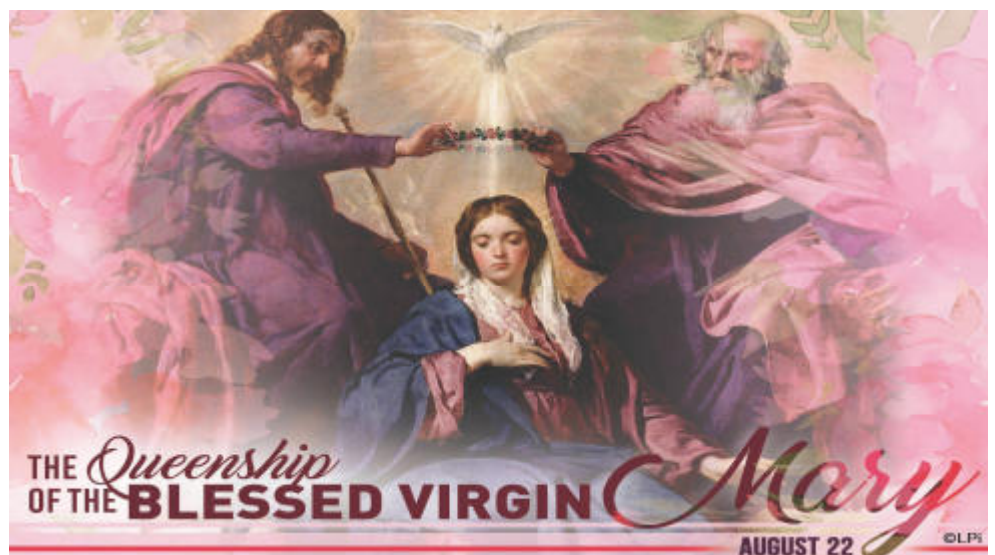

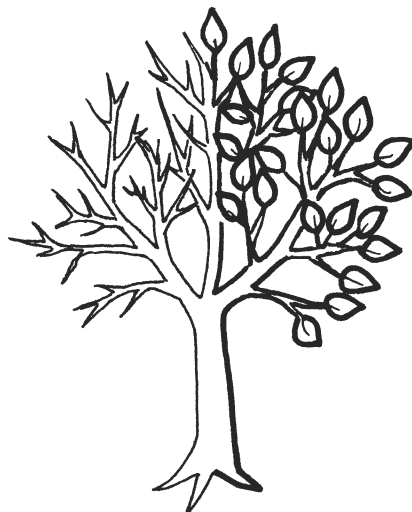
