

Did you know most front-loading washing machines are energy- and water-efficient, using just over 20 gallons a load, while most top-loading machines, unless they are energy-efficient, use 40 gallons per load? Energy Star dishwashers use about 4 gallons of water per load, and even standard

machines use only about 6 gallons. Hand washing generally uses about 20 gallons of water each time!






