

From Our Pastor

Dear Missionary Disciples of Christ,

On Friday, June 24 of this year, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. We will again gather and pray our third annual novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

What is a novena? "A term used to describe a continuous praying of a formula for a personal devotion, either on nine consecutive days or once a week for nine weeks. Most often these prayers are for a particular intention and are in honor of a particular saint or aspect of Christ. The practice derives only from the seventeenth century; however, the number nine derives from the time Mary and the Apostles waited for the coming of the Holy Spirit between Ascension and Pentecost." (Catholic Encyclopedia OSV)

We will gather in the church at 7 p.m. every evening starting on Thursday, June 16, with a closing Mass on Friday, June 24. Each night, the novena will consist of readings, a short reflection, and the novena prayers. On Friday, we will celebrate the Source and Summit (Mass) with the novena prayers and then have a celebration following. All are welcome. Of course, you can say the novena anywhere you wish at whatever time you would like. The novena is available on the parish website at https://sacred-heart-novena-1.




