A special thanks to our top three fundraisers.

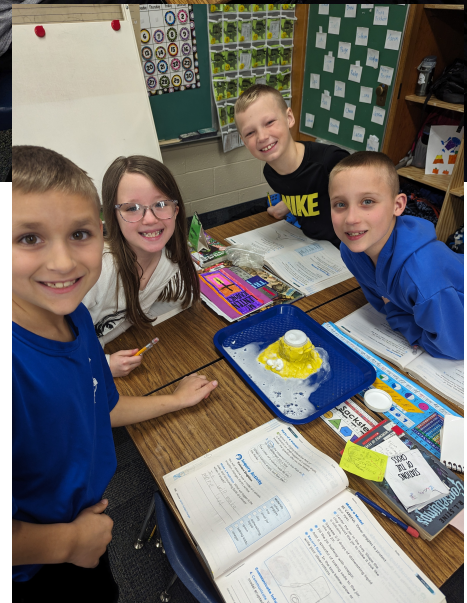
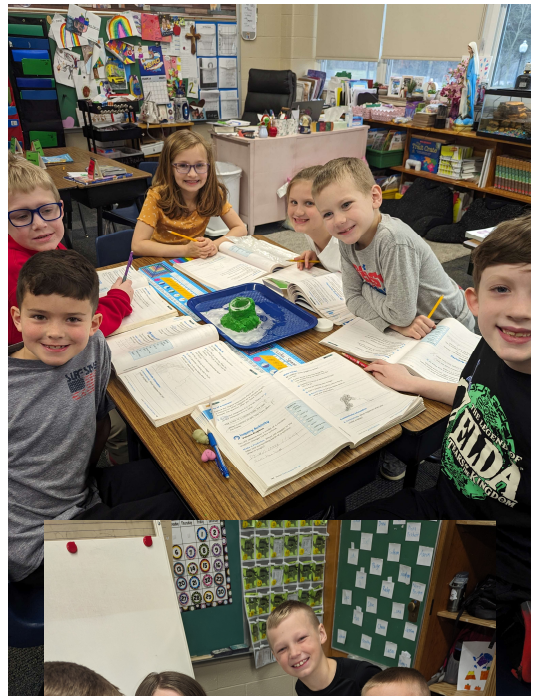

INDIANA CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP Qualification Requirements

- Student(s) must have legal settlement in Indiana.
- Student(s) must be at least 5 years of age by October 1, 2024.
- Student(s) must be a member of a household with an annual income below the income limits in the chart below.

2	\$151,256
3	\$191,068

Estimated Scholarship...\$6,100

St. Michael School is an Indiana Choice School and your student(s) may be eligible for a Choice Scholarship to offset tuition costs.

The student tuition rate for Kindergarten through Eighth grade is \$6,100 per student for the 2024-2025 school year.

The Indiana State Choice Scholarship (Voucher) program is available to all students in grades K-8 who meet the state requirements. For the 2023-2024 school year, approximately 90% of the students attending St. Michael School qualified for the Indiana State Choice Scholarship program. The scholarships covered all of their tuition cost.

*Each family is required to volunteer a minimum of 40 hours (yearly) at St. Michael School or St. Michael Church functions.

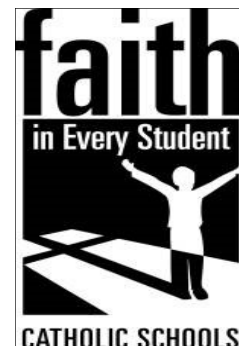
