Lust

Lust is a strong passion or longing, especially for sexual desires.

The Bible speaks about lust in 2 Timothy 2:22, "Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love [and] peace..."

Giving into one's intense longings for sexual gratification is the root cause of infidelity, prom-

iscuity, licentiousness, and in the contemporary world, sexual addiction, the cause of broken relationships, broken marriages, unsuccessful marriages, unsuccessful family life, and their deep and oftentimes devastating negative emotional consequences." The hook up culture based on the concept of instant gratification is a great example of lust. Powered by technology and applications such as Tinder, it makes satisfying your lust easier than it was maybe a few years ago.
