Welcome to Holy Week! This week prepares us for the BIGGEST event of all time-Jesus rising from the dead. I would ask for your prayers and participation.

Tuesday at 2 p.m. - Chrism Mass at the Cathedral. Priests renew their ordination promises and receive the oils for all of our celebrations in our parish. If you are free to join us for Mass, that would be great. Otherwise please pray for us at that time.

Holy Thursday at 6:30 p.m. begins one event with three celebrations: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday. Thursday unites the power of the Last Supper with the action of the foot washing. We pattern our lives after what Jesus did.

Good Friday. We offer a pattern of reflection and remembrance throughout the entire day. The Stations of the Cross at 12 Noon to unite us to the beginning of Jesus' Crucifixion. Individual Reconciliation after the Stations until 3 p.m. to place our sins upon the cross. At 3 p.m., the Divine Mercy Chaplet unites our prayer to Jesus' death. At 5:30 p.m., the Good Friday Service reflects upon the entirety of this day.

Easter Vigil at 8 p.m. on Saturday enters into the promise of the Resurrection. Also, we welcome all those who have come to the faith with a full embrace. I would encourage you to take the risk and allow the fullness of this celebration to embrace you.

This week invites us into the life of Christ, the history of God's saving work, and it assures us of our place in God's work. So clear your schedules, take off work, and take the risk of giving God a little more time. May God bless and keep you this Holy Week.




