

Last Sunday and again this Sunday for 1st Communion we invited the children up around the Altar. It was not your usual quiet, solemn space to be in as Christ came to us there!

Being there was a unique experience for these boys and girls, and a thought-provoking one. I found it reminiscent of our actual family table of ten growing up. Happily nothing was spilled as was often the case for McDermott meals! But I was reminded of the energy and messiness of our lives that we offer to God at Mass. We share ourselves honestly at the family table and God wants the same as we give ourselves to Him, so He can give Himself to us. Jesus just wants us there regardless to "do this in memory of Me" so the Food we receive can keep us growing and alive.

Many university studies point to the real benefits of prioritizing family meals together. They include: "kids have higher grades and larger vocabularies; they also develop greater resilience and have lower rates of depression, substance abuse and obesity. Plus, they have better nutrition."

Life experience tells us the same benefits are even more true of "letting the children come to Me" at Mass as a family meal! Nothing is more nutritious for emotional and spiritual well-being than Christ's Body and Blood, and where else will one's vocabulary be stretched to include Greek words like "Eucharist?"

Jesus came, He said, that "we might have life, and have it to the full!" The family table reveals the messiness of life: it can be work to be there and a challenge to schedule. But its also where life's messiness is brought to Jesus for healing and hope, and the family reminds itself we are loved and welcome in each others' lives. Life to the full is helped by having family meals. None more-so than by the one we call The Mass. Thanks all for bringing your families!

It is so beautiful that we will hear the Gospel reading of the two disciples on the Road to Emmaus for our First Communion Mass this weekend. We reflected on the Road to Emmaus at our First Communion retreat. This passage is a concrete example of how God calls us and forms us, with all aspects of our parish mission:

Encounter Christ: "Jesus himself drew near and walked with them..."

Embrace Deeper Faith: "Were not our hearts burning within us while he... opened the scriptures to us?"

Empower Christian Action: "So they set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven..."

This passage has it all, including the important emphasis on the Eucharist! As soon as Jesus took bread, blessed it, broke it and gave it to them "their eyes were opened and they recognized him." May we all approach the Eucharist with the same excitement and enthusiasm every Mass that our First Communicants have felt receiving Him for the first time!

Baptism
