Priest: Lift up your hearts.



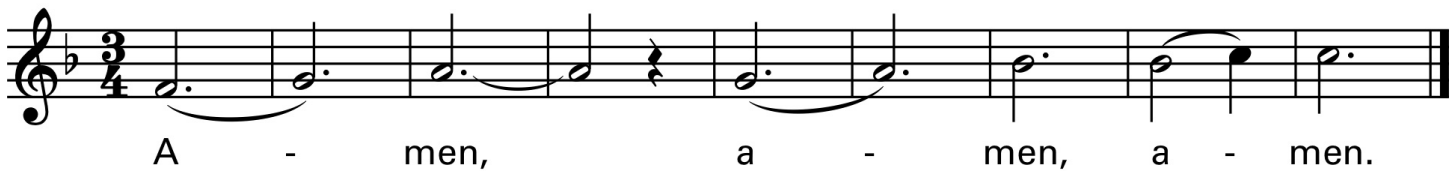

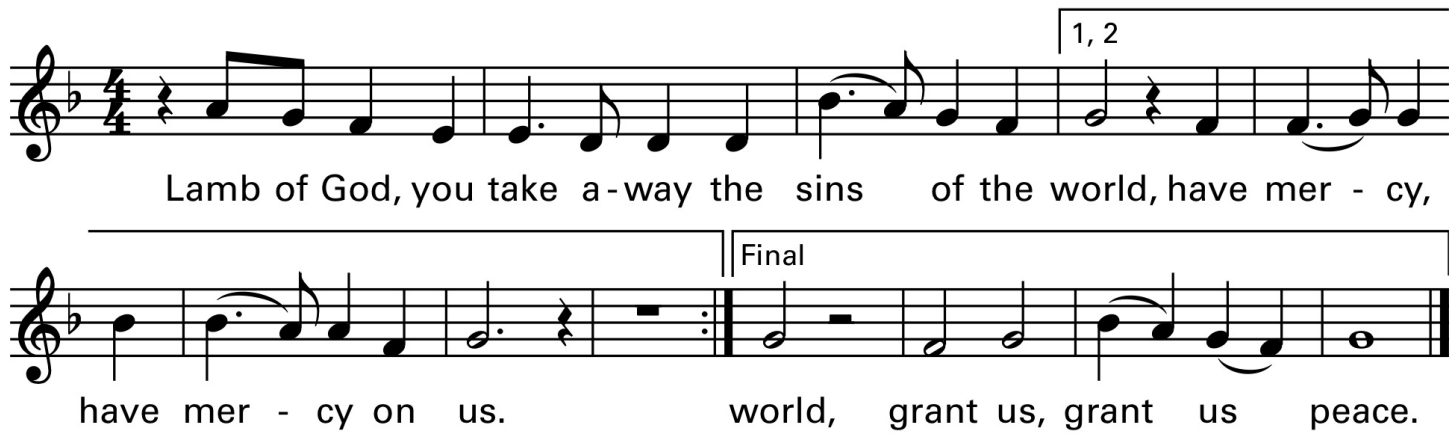
