### **OLD BUSINESS:**

## Presentation on Boy Scouts Request for Permanent Space in Convent Building

- Deacon Travis King -Boy Scout Charter Representative presented the following:
- The scouts have grown in five (5) years to sixty (60) scouts in grades kindergarten through fifth grade.
- Scouts Venturing Crew provides leadership, personal development and high adventure activities. They participate in badge training and an annual retreat.
- The Scouts are in need of more space due to their growth in participants.
- A slide show presentation was provided illustrating the project design for use in the convent building.
- Phase 1-Cleaning- water damage, mitigating mold (work with Tom Kann) and prepping for the next phase. Tentative timeline is February through July
- Phase 2- Paint colors and details to be determined, including furniture, fixtures and Scout items. The color scheme would be the Boy Scouts of American theme.

- South Wall- fireplace ands Boy Scout flag; ast Wall- Pictures of the Eagle Scouts- with name and year; North Wall-Barn doors; Scout oath; Art wall- with decals and design; West Wall-Troop photos, and area on how to tie knots;
- Full wood blinds/shades;
- A meeting space/board room;
- Storage area for Scout supplies- shelves for plastic bins;
- Refrigerator to store drinks and food; coffee bar;
- Scouts can earn badges for painting and home repair- they can participate in the project to earn these badges;
- The Scouts are excited about this project for increased space;
- Divider wall would be removed:
- Tear flooring out and provide a nice even floor such as tile and durable. Could be similar to the preschool room;
- Paint the hallway were the coat racks are;
- Bathrooms are nearby;
- There would be break during the Summer with no work on the project;
- Charge small rental fee for the Scout space with a rental agreement put in place and rental insurance obtained by the Scouts; Rich will be contacted to discuss this further;
- Other groups/organizations could also use this space if needed;
- Scouts meet every Monday;
- Fogarty Hall is used more often since the remodel;
- This area the Sisters reside in is complete;
- Budget- Approximately \$5,000. The Scouts are a nonprofit- 501C-3. If they get account at Lowe's a fifty percent (50%) donation is provided by Lowe's to the nonprofit. Also could look into corporate matching gifts.
- A discussion was brought up regarding updating the Rectory/office staff area and this would not take place until Summer 2026. This will be a future agenda item.
- Most members are in favor of this project- it was discussed to have this area as a multipurpose use and possible scale back slightly on some of the design parts;
- A discussion amongst Council Members and will let the Scouts know in the near future
