Try this for me. Sign yourself with the Sign of the Cross, right now. What did you say while you did? I'll bet that you said, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit," if not out loud, at least in your head. It's what we've been taught since we were children, but what are we actually saying.

First of all, it's a mystery, one of the central mysteries of our faith, the Trinity. It's a good thing to just sit and ponder, one God in three persons. So, what do we mean when we say, "in the name of?" I've heard it said that we must look to the root of our language for the answer. In ancient times, when a decree went out from the king and was proclaimed to the people it was stated "In the name of King ... I pronounce..." So, it is with the authority of the king that the proclamation is made. Think of it this way. When we were baptized, we were claimed for all eternity by the authority of God the Father, the authority of Jesus the Son, and the authority of the Holy Spirit. Pretty powerful to think of, huh.

It's also pretty powerful to think that this is how we usually begin and end our prayers, with authority. It's not just some random act that we were taught as a child, but with the authority of God (in three persons). Now, sign yourself again and know that you are God's.


