Members faithfully attend meetings and prayerfully listen and respond to the Holy Spirit and consider how to fund the parish mission. They review parish financial statements and give input to parish projects. Financial background is helpful, but NOT required. A prayerful and discerning spirit is a more critical attribute.

Meetings are typically the Third Wednesday evening from 6:00 to 7:30 Sep, Nov, Jan, Mar, Apr, May (June is possible, depending upon the budget process)
