Both will be receiving the full Rites of Initiation which is how things were done from the beginning. We will also be celebrating First Communion with Cesar Cruz Maldonado.

It is our duty as a community of believers, then, to take these neophyte (new) Christian under our wing and help them become followers of Jesus. Many of the things that we do and say during our worship have just become second nature to us. Things like genuflecting, the sign of the cross, praying the Rosary, and receiving Jesus in the Eucharist become routine, and we do them without thinking about why. May the Holy Spirit continue to touch hearts and call people to his Holy Church. And may we, as a community of disciples, continue to welcome them with open arms.
