DEACON'S CORNER

You may have heard the saying, "those who sing, pray twice." It is often attributed to St. Augustine of Hippo. While I had trouble verifying that he is the one who actually stated it, there is some truth to it. Have you ever seen, heard, or been one who sings at the top of your lungs in the car, or when you thought no one was looking? While I'm not saying that singing a song counts twice as much as a prayer, I've found that there's an extra

depth of expression when I sing while praying. In "church" circles this is known as Praise and Worship.

Years ago, while at a Stubenville youth conference, I asked one of the young people next to me what if they were enjoying the Praise and Worship session that we were in the middle of. They offered that they would enjoy it more if they knew the songs. I couldn't agree more. Worship leaders do well with helping people learn the tune and lyrics, but if you're familiar with the songs, the experience becomes a deeper expression of prayer.

To that end, I've been working with Lisa Preissner, who is the worship leader that we've invited to participate in our parish mission. We've come up with a playlist of songs that she will draw from while leading the Praise and Worship sessions of the mission. The YouTube playlist is attached to this week's newsletter. Take some time to listen, internalize, and pray with it, even if you are not able to make it to our mission. After all, "those who sing, pray twice."
