

DEACON'S CORNER

When you pray, what person of the Trinity do you pray to: God the Father; Jesus the Son; or Holy Spirit the Paraclete ("little helper")? Usually when I ask this question of people, the answer will be either to God the Father, or to Jesus. This may because we don't he understand Holy Spirit. We probably don't understand God or Jesus either. But, we have a concept in our heads

of God the fatherly figure and creator of all things, and Jesus the man who walked the earth. They are easier for us to pray to. Spirit, on the other hand, well that's harder to envision.

In ancient Greek, a paraclete is defined as a "little helper." One who walks alongside, who guides. Hearing a definition like this, I can't help to think about my grandchildren. Whenever we go for a walk, especially near a busy street, I like to reach down and hold their hand, to give them a "little help" and keep them from walking into harm's way. When they want help with something, they will come up and grab me by the hand, and show me what they want help with. This gives me a good visual of how a relationship with Holy Spirit works.

When we read in Scripture about Holy Spirit, we are given images of wind, flames, and doves. These are all great images, but we should also remember that Jesus calls Holy Spirit the Paraclete. So, let me offer you a simple little pray you can offer, the next time you need "a little help." Come, Holy Spirt!
