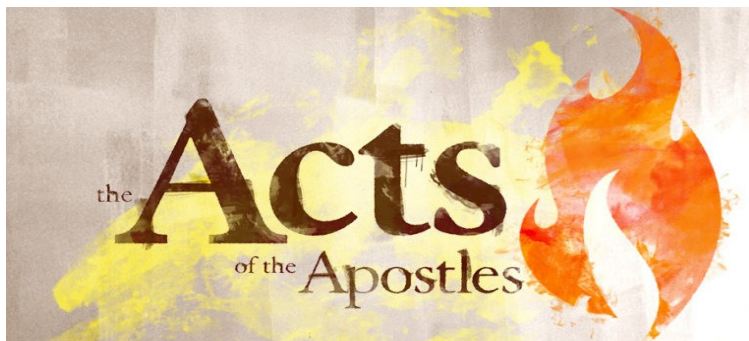
ALEXANDRINA HOUSE
