Comprehensive School Improvement Plan 2018-2019 Results

Sacred Heart School's Long-Range Goals:

Reading: By the year 2025, all students will meet the benchmark on the Spring FAST Literacy Assessment.

Math: By the year 2025, all students will meet the benchmark on the Spring FAST Math Assessment.

Annual Goals Results:

State Goal:

In the spring of 2018, 75% of students in grades K through 6 were at or above the benchmark on the FAST Literacy Screener. By the spring of 2018, we will increase that percentage to 76%. In the Spring of 2019, 66% of students in grades K through 6 were at or above the benchmark on the FAST Literacy Screener. *THE GOAL WAS NOT MET*.

Local Goals:

During the 2018-2019 school year, it is our goals that 81% of students will meet their projected growth in **Reading** on the Iowa Assessments or MAP Assessments.

Results: During the 2018-2019 school year, 91% of students met their projected growth in Reading on the Iowa Assessments or MAP Assessments. *THE GOAL WAS MET*.

During the 2018-2019 school year, it is our goal that 81% of students will meet their projected growth in **Math** on the Iowa Assessments or MAP Assessments.

Results: During the 2018-2019 school year, 92% of students met their projected growth in Math on the Iowa Assessments or MAP Assessments. *THE GOAL WAS MET*.

Goals for the 2019-2020 School Year

Academic Goals:

- 80% of students in grades K through 6 will meet the benchmark on the Spring FAST Literacy Assessment.
- 80% of students in grades K through 6 will meet the benchmark on the Spring FAST Math Assessment.

Wellness Goals:

- Implement activities to promote staff wellness and health.
- Promote walking/biking to school, active indoor recesses and physical activity beaks within the school day.
- Follow Iowa School Nutrition Program guidelines regarding portion sizes for school breakfasts and lunches.
