

## From the Desk of Fr. Beckman:

As we celebrate Memorial Day by remembering all who served our country throughout our history, let's reflect on the lyrics of the popular tune that Daniel Butterfield composed and Horace Lorenzo Trim lyricized. The lyrics to "Taps" were added after the original musical composition by Daniel Butterfield. While little is known on how they were written, they are often attributed to Horace Lorenzo Trim, although his authorship is often debated as well. Nonetheless, the origin of the lyrics lost throughout the ages have become seemingly inconsequential when compared to the overall meaning of the song. As we approach Memorial Day, let us not forget the meaning behind "Taps." What started as a simple bugle call has become a tradition at funerals for not only those who served in the military, but also First Responders. During a volatile time in our history, when the nation was divided and brothers fought against brothers, Butterfield had no idea that a modest bugle call would come to unite the nation in remembrance of all who served. "Taps" would become a perpetual memorial.

Day is done, gone the sun,  
From the lake, from the hills, from the sky;  
All is well, safely rest, God is nigh.

Fading light, dims the sight,  
And a star gems the sky, gleaming bright.  
From afar, drawing nigh, falls the night.

Thanks and praise, for our days,  
'Neath the sun, 'neath the stars, 'neath the sky;  
As we go, this we know, God is nigh.

(Boy Scout Verse)  
Sun has set, shadows come,  
Time has fled, Scouts must go to their beds  
Always true to the promise that they made.

While the light fades from sight,  
And the stars gleaming rays softly send,  
To thy hands we our souls, Lord, commend.


