2025-2027 IMPACT Program for Catholic Adults






Annual Mass at Monti

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Luke 9:11-17

A Catholic friend of mine occasionally says, "The Eucharist is not a noun. It's a verb." In so saying, he is making the point that the Eucharist isn't simply Jesus' bodily presence given to us in holy Communion. It also manifests the dynamic pattern by which Christ actively loves and saves us. He teaches us to cooperate with that pattern. This Eucharist actually embodies four verbs: Jesus takes, blesses, breaks, and gives. Let's consider each one.

He takes: Do we acknowledge that we are totally in God's hands? Do we receive everything in our lives as a gift, and act responsibly with it?

He blesses: Do we actively reflect that Jesus makes us holy in our baptism? Do we embrace our bodies and souls as temples of God, worthy of love, peace, and joy?

He breaks: Do we run from failure and disappointment, from getting old or being ignored? Are we too worried about getting hurt or sick? Do we embrace our sufferings with confidence?

He gives: Are we willing to make our lives a gift for others? Are we confident that we will always have enough love to give to others, that God will always provide enough for us? Do we rejoice in giving away what we have to others, expecting nothing in return? This is the dynamic life the Eucharist empowers us to live.

From the Desk of Fr. Beckman:

On this Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, a feast that celebrates unity, oneness, and peace in Christ, the world processes reports of Israeli airstrikes against the Iranian regime's military and nuclear weapons program. Christians should think carefully about how to respond. On one hand, we lament the loss of human life that wars bring as we follow our Lord in affirming, "blessed are the peacemakers" (Matthew 5:9). On the other hand, we also learn from Jesus that "wars and rumors of wars" (Matthew 24:6) will characterize this fallen world until he returns. Therefore, I thought it would be good to remind everyone of the importance to reflect on the six principles of the Just War Theory. Recognizing that there sometimes is "a time for war" (Ecclesiastes 3:8), Christian theologians since the fourth century have developed universal principles for Just War — that is, defining the conditions under which war is justified. Just War Theory actually goes back to the fourth-century theologian Augustine who articulated some of these principles, and it's been expanded upon since then."

The six principles of Just War Theory:

- First, "There needs to be a just cause. You can't just go to war for any reason. ... This rules out a war of aggression from the start."
- Second, "There has to be right intention. A nation goes to war to end grave injustice or to restore peace. You can't just go to war because you don't like your enemy, you don't like the nation next door. You can't go simply because of vengeance."
- Third, "A just war needs to be waged by a legitimate authority. This would rule out individual actors or groups."
- Fourth, "War should be a last resort. ... Christians should never be the people itching to go to war. You exhaust all options before you think about war."
- Fifth, "There would need to be proportionate objectives — all things considered, in terms of loss of life that might be lost or money that might be lost. ... The things that you might lose in a war can outweigh what you're trying to remedy."
- Sixth, "There needs to be a reasonable chance of success. I would point people to Luke chapter 14." In describing the cost of discipleship, Jesus uses this metaphor, "Or what king, going out to encounter another king in war, will not sit down first and deliberate whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? And if not, while the other is yet a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks for terms of peace" (Luke 14:31-32).

My intention is not provide an analysis of this war between Israel and Iran, nor to apply each principle of the Just war Theory to it; that is up to those who know so much more about that I do, but simply to remind us of the severity of war and the caution that one must take before engaging in war. Because of the depth of this issue and the limited amount of space I have here, I will make a few more brief comments next week.
