From the Desk of Fr. Beckman:

The six principles of The Just War Theory that I outlined in last week's bulletin provide a framework for analyzing Israel's airstrikes against the Iranian regime, both of which are non-Christian nations, through a biblical worldview. It is the responsibility of each Christian leader, and dare I say other leaders who claim the one, true, monotheistic God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob as both the Jews and Muslims do, to consider these principles before engaging in war. As individual members within society, it is impossible for us to know all of the details involved and so we educate ourselves in the best way possible if we are to offer any judgment whatsoever on the matter. We must trust our leaders that they are making wise decisions according to these time tested Just War principles.

The fact that war is an unavoidable feature of our fallen world does not mean Christians should be fond of it. Even just wars, as outlined above, are permissible only under narrow conditions, as a last resort, by the proper authority.

By contrast, Christians are entrusted with "the ministry of reconciliation," writes Paul, "that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God" (2 Corinthians 5:18-20). Christians should act and pray for peace.

As we celebrate our independence as a nation this 4th of July, let us be grateful to God who has given us the freedom, liberty, and justice that a lot of nation still long for. **HAPPY FOURTH OF JULY!**

Sts. Peter And Paul, Apostles
Matthew 16:13-19

What do you call brothers who are born on the same day? Twins, of course. That is what we celebrate today in the inestimable saints, Peter and Paul. Wait: twins? Yes. The early Church believed that Peter and Paul were martyred in Rome on the same day. Since the day of martyrdom is celebrated as a saints' birth into eternal life, the result is striking: Peter and Paul are twins in God's family, the Church.

Who should care about this? Well, anyone who longs to live in a world marked by love and peace. Remember, the Romans believed that twins, Romulus and Remus, founded their city through an act of fratricide, the former murdering the latter. Sadly, the structures of this fallen world emerge through violence between those who should love each other. But in the Church, a new city has been founded upon this new set of twins, embodying the non-violent power of Jesus' cross and resurrection.

That's why traditional icons represent Peter and Paul in a fraternal and warm embrace. Contrasted with the violence of Rome's founders, it challenges us with a bold claim: do we believe that structures of merciful love are more powerful and lasting than those based on power, violence, and domination? Am I willing to see others in my life as my "twin," with whom I am called to give my life for Christ, or as my rival? Am I committed to living what is embodied in Romulus and Remus, or in Peter and Paul?
