

From the Desk of Fr. Beckman:

Archbishop meets with church leaders in Kenya: Part 1 by Jill Kruse-Domeyer

On July 26, after a journey that spanned two days and included three flights, Archbishop Thomas Zinkula arrived at his destination: the city of Nairobi, in the East African country of Kenya.

Archbishop Zinkula came to Nairobi primarily to meet with church leaders there. The visit was not his first time in Africa. It was actually his third. But it was his first time visiting the continent as the chair of the USCCB Subcommittee on the Church in Africa, a role he has held since spring of 2025.

During his time in Kenya, Archbishop Zinkula visited with Archbishop Philip Anyolo of Nairobi and the apostolic nuncio to Kenya, Archbishop Hubertus van Megen. He also met with members of the Kenya Conference of Catholic Bishops, the Association of Member Episcopal Conferences in Eastern Africa, and the Association of Consecrated Women in Eastern and Central Africa.

Accompanying Archbishop Zinkula on his visit to Nairobi was Fritz Zuger, a consultant for the USCCB with a great knowledge of the church in Africa. Zuger is a member of the Focolare Movement, an international lay Catholic movement focused on promoting unity and fraternity. Archbishop Zinkula and Zuger visited Mariapolis Piero, a small community founded by the Focolare Movement outside of Nairobi. At Mariapolis Piero, Archbishop Zinkula celebrated Mass and also received a community tour.

On his last day in Kenya, Archbishop Zinkula met with the Sisters of Mary Immaculate, from the city of Nyeri. The sisters run Maria Immaculata Hospital in Nairobi.

Archbishop Zinkula's time in Kenya was the first portion of a larger visit to Africa. On July 30, he left Nairobi for Kigali, Rwanda, to represent the U.S. bishops at the 20th Plenary Assembly of the Symposium of Episcopal Conferences of Africa and Madagascar. He then headed to Ghana, to visit the Diocese of Techiman and the Archdiocese of Cape Coast, both of which have sent priests for mission work in the Archdiocese of Dubuque in recent years.

Participants will learn more about:


- Rationale, process, and timeline for Journey in Faith
- Importance of prayer and synodal listening in this process
- Proposed pastorate models as possible new groupings of parishes for the future
- Ways to listen, learn, ask questions and provide insights throughout the process including engaging in your parish's October and November local meetings and providing written feedback via the Journey in Faith website

There are **34 September Regional Journey in Faith Information Sessions** from which to choose. Each is held in a parish church and is scheduled for three hours. Parishioners should attend a meeting held in their Regional Planning Area (RPA). The overall information will be the same at each meeting, however, the proposed pastorate models that are explained will be specific to your RPA. (See RPA (v5) for your region.) **We will be holding a meeting here at St. John's (Independence) on Saturday, September 20 from 9:00 - 12:00.**

If you are unable to attend a September regional meeting, you are urged to review all of the information on the website including videos, maps, and spreadsheets that will be released on September 2nd. This will enable you to have background prior to attending your own local parish's meetings in October and November. A summary video with key points from those meetings about prayer and synodal listening will be released at the end of September.
