From the Desk of Fr. Beckman:

Advent Wreath

As we light the symbol of our Advent season the circular, *evergreen wreath* symbolizes life and is a reminder that God’s love never changes, it is unending; it is “ever green” and that God is the giver of eternal life, and these candles symbolize the virtues of *hope, peace, joy, and love* and the actions of *waiting(watching), announcing, fulfilling, and proclaiming*.

The first candle lit is called the *Prophets* candle. It reminds us of the *hope* of Jesus’ coming, the *expectation/waiting/watching* for his arrival (Mt. 24:42). It is purple (repentance) in color. Can you name some Old Testament Prophets? Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, Ezra, Jonah, Micah, Obadiah, Hosea, Amos, Joel, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Zechariah, Malachi, Baruch, Hagai.

The second candle lit is called the *Bethlehem* candle, *announcing* the place of Jesus’ birth, and the love he brings to our hearts and homes (Micah 5:2). It is purple (repentance) in color. Where did Jesus grow up? Nazareth / Where did Jesus suffer his passion? Jerusalem / Where, around what sea, did Jesus do a lot of his ministry? Galilee, Gennesaret, Tiberias

The third candle lit is the *Angel’s* candle, which represents the *fulfillment and joy* that Christ’s birth brings (Luke 2:8-14). It is rose/pink (joy) in color. Name some of the Angels: Gabriel, Raphael, Michael, Seraphim, Cherubim, Host of Heavenly

The fourth candle lit is the *Shepherd’s* candle, which represents the proclamation and *peace* he brought to that holy night (Luke 2:15-20). It is purple (repentance) in color. Can you name any of the Shepherds? David

These candles symbolize the *virtues of hope, love, joy and peace*, and the actions of *waiting/watching, announcing, fulfilling, and proclaiming*.

A large white *Christmas* candle can be placed in the center of the wreath during the Christmas season representing *Jesus Christ, the Light of the World*.

- The Advent wreath contains significant colors and meaning.
- The *evergreen* itself symbolizes life and is a reminder that God’s love never changes; it is “ever green” and giver of life.
 - The *circle* symbolizes a God who has no beginning and no end and whose love surrounds us both in good times and difficult challenging times.
 - The three *purple candles* symbolize a penitential sorrow and a reminder that we are called to be more loving and giving.
 - The *rose candle*, lit on the third Sunday of Advent, symbolizes the joy in anticipation of Jesus’ coming.
 - The ritual of the lighting of the candles is done as a reminder to follow Jesus, the Light of the World, as the Magi followed the star to the crib and beyond as they walked in the light of Christ.
