

ST. MATTHIAS PARISH HI-LITES

Hi Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

May the Holy Spirit lead us and guide us in our discipleship as we live our faith in the 6th week of Ordinary Time. February 7-14 has been designated as National Marriage Week. During this week we pray for the sanctity of the Sacrament of Marriage and Family Life. We also lift up in prayer everyone who is living out their baptismal commitment in the Covenant of the Sacrament of Marriage. In gratitude for their witness of covenant love in God as it is expressed in the Sacrament of Marriage, we pray in our appreciation for them and to give them strength.

On January 31, Wednesday, the clergy of Greene County and Washington County met together at Immaculate Conception Church, Washington, Pa. The clergy met with Bishop Mark Eckman, Vicar for Clergy and Clergy Personnel. The meeting was held in order to discuss clergy personnel policy. The number of clergy still active in the Diocese of Pittsburgh was discussed. There will be a point in time when Deacons will out number the Priests. Because of the clergy stats and the number of priest candidates in the seminary, the diocese is asking all Parishes to pray for Vocations to the Priesthood and to form a Vocation Committee. St. Matthias Parish will be forming a Vocation Committee and more details will be forthcoming in the days ahead in recruiting volunteers for this committee.

The Annual Parish Appeal for the Diocese of Pittsburgh will begin this weekend which has been designated as Commitment Weekend. The Annual Parish Appeal replaces the Parish Share Program. Some of the parameters of the Annual Appeal differ from the Parish Share Program. The Annual Appeal Program and its uses are explained in a letter from me that everyone should have received already. Your generosity and support of this appeal will support the services that we use and need as a parish, such as grants for our faith formation programs, department services that assist us as a parish to create vibrant parishes, and other resources. Our annual fee is \$87,166.00 which will be taken out from the parish Annual Appeal account. On a monthly basis, \$7,263.83 will be taken out from the account for this appeal.

Funds for the Elementary School Grant will be deducted in a similar way. The St. Matthias Parish fee for the School Grant is \$49,456.00. Every month \$4,121.33 will be deducted from the school grant account.

Ash Wednesday occurs this week on February 14 and marks the beginning of the season of penance called Lent. The marks of this season are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. One act out of many which occurs during Lent is "giving up" something. The whole idea of "giving up" something is to do more in Christian Charity and Love of neighbor. As a reminder, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Fasting begins at the age of 14 and fasting consists of one full meal and two lighter meals. Fast and abstinence is an obligation for everyone between the ages of 18-59. If one has a medical condition and fasting and abstinence may cause physical harm, another act of penance and charity should be done. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence from meat (refrain from eating meat) Lent is also a time when the Stations of the Cross devotions are celebrated. Please consult the bulletin for times and days at all the Churches for St. Matthias Parish. Lent is also a time to celebrate the Sacrament of reconciliation (Confession). In addition to the usual 11:00 AM times on Saturday at the parish Churches, the "Light is on For You" diocesan wide evening of Confessions will be held on March 6, Wednesday. There will also be a parish Penance Service on March 25, Monday. Times for both of these Penance Service celebrations will be in the upcoming bulletins. There will be an Anointing Mass at St. Marcellus Church on March 14, Thursday at 7:00 PM. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is for anyone of any age who is suffering from spiritual, emotional, or physical illness. Individuals who are scheduled for surgery can be anointed also.

Please be sure to support our St. Matthias Parish Fish Frys which are at St. Marcellus Church and St. Ann Church. Check the bulletin for menu items and times.

Please take the time during this season of Lent through acts of Penance, Christian Charity, and Faith in order to be prepared for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery which is the way that we are called to live the Love of God everyday. Blessings to all for your celebration of the Holy Season of Lent!!!!

GUATEMALA MISSION OF ST. MATTHIAS FEBRUARY 2024

St Matthias Parish/St Ann has helped provide for the care and education of the children since 1991. Because of your donations, (24) children have completed technical degrees and continue to live and work in their home country.





Reyna (L) and Patricia (R) graduate from high school. Both are beginning Technical school: Reyna studying Accounting and Patricia studying as a Pre-school teacher.

Recently Madre Reyna sent information required to report to the courts on the children at the Children's Home and Nutritional Center. Most of them had been brought to the Hogar because of severe malnutrition, often due to the alcoholism of their parents. Malnutrition affects their ability to learn. The Hogar must work on their nutritional health while also assessing the best route for their education. Many of the children who are older when they come to the Hogar have not had formal education. The never-ending efforts of the nuns, workers at the Hogar, the perseverance and hard work of the children have yielded incredible results!

Part of the Hogar's work also is to help reconnect the children to their own families as soon as possible. Many of the older girls have been able to reconnect with their older siblings who remained at home and feel a part of their family again.

St. Matthias Parish has been blessed to be partners in their success stories through your financial assistance and prayers of support. Of course, the work never ends. Although many of the children are older, healthier, and achieve academic success, new children are entering and presenting new challenges. We must continue to support them in any way we can, particularly with our prayers.
