St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) Feast Day, August 9

A brilliant philosopher who was Jewish, Edith Stein stopped believing in God when she was 14. She later was so captivated by reading the autobiography of Saint Teresa of Avila that she began a spiritual journey that led to her Catholic baptism in 1922. Twelve years later she imitated Saint Teresa by becoming a Carmelite nun, taking the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross.

In 1913, Edith became a student at the University of Göttingen in Germany. She became fascinated by phenomenology--an approach to philosophy. Excelling as a protégé of Edmund Husserl, one of the leading phenomenologists and a mathematician, Edith earned a doctorate in philosophy in 1916.

In the summer of 1921, she spent several weeks in Bergzabern at the country estate of her friend, Hedwig Conrad-Martius, another of Husserl's students. Hedwig had converted to Protestantism with her husband. One evening Edith picked up an autobiography of St Teresa of Avila and read the book all night. "When I had finished the book, I said to myself: this is the truth". Later, looking back on her life, she wrote: "My longing for truth was a single prayer".

She continued as a university teacher until 1922, when she moved to a Dominican school in Speyer; her appointment as lecturer at the Educational Institute of Munich ended under pressure from the Nazis.

On 1 January 1922 Edith Stein was baptized. "I had given up practicing my Jewish religion when I was a 14-year old girl and did not begin to feel Jewish again until I had returned to God". From this moment on she was continually aware that she belonged to Christ not only spiritually, but also through blood. On the feast of the Purification of Mary—another day with an Old Testament connection—she was confirmed by the Bishop of Speyer in his private chapel.

Edith Stein entered the Carmelite convent of Cologne on October 14 and was clothed in the habit on April 15, 1934. After living for four years in the Cologne Carmel, Sister Teresa Benedicta moved to the Carmelite monastery in Echt, Netherlands, in 1938. The Nazis occupied that country in 1940. In retaliation for the Dutch bishops denouncing the Nazi, all Dutch Jews who had become Christians were arrested. Teresa Benedicta and her sister Rosa, also a Catholic, died in a gas chamber in Auschwitz on August 9, 1942.

Pope John Paul II beatified Teresa Benedicta of the Cross in 1987 and canonized her 12 years later.






