"I Believe in the Resurrection of the Body"

Recently, I was in a conversation where I began to understand the other person, a Christian, did not believe in the resurrection of the body. As the conversation proceeded it became necessary to say, "I don't believe what you believe, I believe in the resurrection of the body." We prefer not to have conflict with our fellow Christians, but sometimes we must state the truth of our faith. And we profess at every Mass, "I believe in the resurrection of the body."

When we profess this belief, we mean we not only believe in the immortality of the soul after death, but we believe that even our mortal bodies will come to life again. It is an essential element of the Christian faith from the beginning. St. Paul said, "How can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised; if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain, and your faith is in vain... But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep" (1 Cor 15:12-14).

From the beginning, the resurrection of the dead has been opposed. Belief in a spiritual afterlife is common. But how can we believe that our bodies could rise to everlasting life when they will become like dust? But what is death but the separation of the soul from the body. The human body decays and the soul goes to meet God while awaiting its reunion with its glorified body. God will grant uncorruptible life to our bodies by reuniting them with our souls, through the power of Jesus' Resurrection. In Him, "all ... will rise again with their own bodies," but Christ "will change our lowly bodies to be like His glorious body," into a "spiritual body" (CCC.997; 999).

We must be gentle sometimes with our fellow Christians, but do not be confused about the truth. Christ will raise our bodies from the dead on the last day (cf. John 6:40).
