Purgatory

Talking to children is like talking to young theologians. They ask the most marvelous questions. Recently a young girl asked me, "What is purgatory?"

Basically, purgatory is a place to get cleaned up.

If we die in God's friendship and grace, we are assured of eternal salvation. But we are imperfect and need to be "cleaned up" or purified to attain the holiness we require to enter the presence of God. The Church gives the name "purgatory" to this final purification, which is completely different from the punishment of the damned in hell. The Church, including you and me, commend the dead to God's mercy and offer her prayers, beginning with the funeral Mass, on their behalf. But Christ has warned us that hell is real, so the Church prays that no one should be lost.

This teaching is based on the practice of praying for the dead mentioned in Holy Scripture. "Therefore [Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin" (2 Macc 12:46). The Church recommends that we offer masses, almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance for our beloved dead. (CCC. 1032, 1030,1054-1058)
