The Baptism of the Lord, January 8, 2024

The Feast of the Baptism of our Lord follows the Epiphany because both are events by which God makes his mystery clearer to the human mind.

In the Epiphany, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity was worshiped by foreigners who had been led to Bethlehem, but the Magi knew only that the Holy Child was the long-awaited Messiah (Anointed One, as King David was anointed). Fast forward to the beginning of that Child's mature ministry, and there it is revealed that he is the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity.

The baptism of our Lord was a symbol and not a sacrament because the sacrament of baptism washes away sin, and Christ had no sin. A sacrament actually confers a grace from God, so our Lord's baptism qualifies as a sacramental. St. John the Baptist did not use the term sacramental, but he described it when he said, "I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit" (Mark 1:8).

But Baptism in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, is one of the seven sacraments. and washes away sin because it confers the grace of God and moves the soul to desire the other sacraments.

Conferring a name in baptism intensifies our relationship with God, who "adopts" us as his sons and daughters. Pope Benedict XVI said, "Every baptized child acquires the character of the son of God, beginning with their Christian name, an unmistakable sign that the Holy Spirit causes men to be born anew in the womb of the Church." So, it is salutary to be careful in choosing names that identify with the great saints who have gone before us.

Parents, let us follow our Lord and lead our children closer to God through the sacraments of the Church, beginning with that important sacrament of Baptism.
