The Magnificat (Canticle of Mary)

My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for He has looked with favor on His lowly servant.

From this day all generations will call me blessed: the Almighty has done great thing for me, and holy is His Name.

He has mercy on those who fear Him in every generation.

He has shown the strength of His arm, He has scattered the proud in their conceit.

He has cast down the mighty from their thrones, and has lifted up the lowly.

He has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich He has sent away empty.

He has come to the help of His servant Israel for He has remembered His promise of mercy, the promise He made to our fathers, to Abraham and his children for ever.

Amen

First Saturday Devotion, Reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary: On Dec 10, 1925 Sr. Lucy, a Fatima seer, was visited by our Blessed Mother and the Child Jesus. The Child Jesus spoke first saying "Have compassion on the Heart of your Most Holy Mother, covered with thorns, with which ungrateful men pierce It at every moment, and there is no one to make an act of reparation to remove them." Then Our Lady added: ".....do you at least try to console Me and announce in My name that I promise to assist at the moment of death, with all the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the Rosary, and keep Me company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to Me."

Why 5 Saturdays? Our Lord revealed His reason to Sr. Lucy on May 29, 1930. He said: "....there are five types of offenses and blasphemies committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary: Blasphemies against Her Immaculate Conception, Blasphemies against Her Virginity, Blasphemies against Her Divine Maternity, refusing at the same time to recognize Her as the Mother of men, the blasphemies of those who publicly seek to sow in the hearts of children indifference or scorn or even hatred of this Immaculate Mother, and the offenses of those who outrage Her directly in Her holy images."
