The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, February 2

The Mysteries of the Rosary center on the events of Christ's life. There are four sets of Mysteries: Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and added by Saint John Paul II in 2002 – Luminous.

The Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary are: The Annunciation; The Visitation; The Nativity; The Presentation; and The Finding of Jesus in the Temple. We can see that as we pray the Rosary, it leads us to meditate closely on the life of Christ.

This week we have another opportunity to make time to meditate on the Presentation of the Lord. The Church has set aside February 2 in observance of the Presentation of the Lord, the day in which Joseph and Mary presented Jesus to the priests and elders in the Temple.

According to Jewish law, the firstborn male child belonged to God, and the parents had to "buy him back" on the 40th day after his birth, by offering a sacrifice of "a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons" (Luke 2:24) in the temple, thus the "presentation" of the child.

When Christ was presented in the temple, "there was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel." When Mary and Joseph brought Christ to the temple, Simeon embraced the Child and prayed the Canticle of Simeon: "Now, Lord, let Your servant depart in peace, according to Your word; for my eyes have seen Your salvation, which You have prepared in the presence of all the peoples: A light for revelation for the Gentiles, and the glory of Your people Israel" (Luke 2:29-32).

If you have not prayed the Rosary in a while, the Feast of the Presentation is an opportunity to take time to spend with Jesus and Mary and meditate on the life of Christ.
