Hurtubise Family Ancestry

Monday, July 26, Descendants of Helen Deslauriers (1851–1931) and Moses Thebodeau (1848–1908) will be acknowledging the passing of 90 years since Helen's death July 13, 1931, at her gravesite in All Saints Cemetery. Helen and Moses were some of the earliest parishioners of All Saints.

Helen's death during the Great Depression likely kept her children from having her name added to the family gravestone. Earlier this month, descendant family members (great grandchildren) had her name added and the gravestone cleaned and repaired. Helen and Moses had 9 children (6 sons and 3 daughters), 31 grandchildren and 99 known great grandchildren.

Family names for Helen and Moses children include: Thebodeau, Brown, Broe (Breault), and Rainey. The family hopes this effort will help those seeking knowledge of their family ancestry and their Richford history.
