



THE PURIFICATION OF THE TEMPLE AND OF RELIGION

The Gospel today, tells us about the purification of the temple. It also announces the replacement of the old temple with the new one. We are the new temple, but like the old, we often need purification from all that hinders our offering up to God acceptable sacrifices.

The second reading shows what kind of purification the Church needs: St. Paul tells us that we must avoid reasoning like the "Jews" and the "Greeks". The first reading, the Decalogue, shows us concretely which sacrifices are acceptable to God. It is an invitation to purify our religion of false notions that do not give proof of our love for God and love of our neighbors.

During Lent, let us make every effort to fulfill the demands of the commandments which Jesus puts them in simple terms for us:

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another (John 15: 34)

LA PURIFICACIÓN DEL TEMPLO Y DE LA RELIGIÓN

El Evangelio de hoy nos habla de la purificación del templo. También anuncia la sustitución del antiguo templo por el nuevo. Somos el templo nuevo, pero al igual que el antiguo, a menudo necesitamos la purificación de todo lo que obstaculiza nuestra ofrenda a los sacrificios aceptables de Dios.

La segunda lectura muestra qué tipo de purificación necesita la Iglesia: San Pablo nos dice que debemos evitar razonar como los "judíos" y los "griegos". La primera lectura, el Decálogo, nos muestra concretamente qué sacrificios son agradables a Dios. Es una invitación a purificar nuestra religión de nociones falsas que no dan prueba de nuestro amor a Dios y amor al prójimo.

Durante la Cuaresma, hagamos todo lo posible para cumplir las exigencias de los mandamientos que Jesús nos pone en términos sencillos:

"Un mandamiento nuevo les doy: que se amen los unos a los otros. Como yo los he amado, deben amarse los unos a los otros (Juan 15:34)
