

MONDAY, DECEMBER 9, 2019 FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

This year, since the feast day of the Immaculate Conception falls on a Sunday, it is transferred to Monday, December 9th because it is the patronal feast day of the U.S. Because it takes place on a Monday, the Bishop's Conference has taken away the obligation of participating at Mass; it is **NOT a holy day of obligation**.
